

Regarding definitive FCI approval of Danish/swedish Farmdog.

The breed clubs of Denmark and Sweden - Dansk/svensk gårdhundeklub (DSGK) and Rasklubben för dansk-svensk gårdshund (RDSG) - have produced the basic documentation for achieving definitive FCI approval of the breed.

The application was sent on June 21, 2018 to DKK and SKK from the two co-working breed clubs.

The application itself has to be sent from a breed's native country's kennel club to the FCI.

In this case, where the breed has two native countries, it is DKK and SKK who have to apply together. Both kennel clubs have earlier this year decided that they wish to pursue definitive FCI approval for the breed, and been in dialogue with us, and each other about this. So they were ready to receive the documents from DSGK and RDSG, and it has also been confirmed received. Therefore we have good reason to believe that they are already working on it.

Now we can only wait. DSGK and RDSG see no reason why FCI should not approve the breed, we consider it a formality. It is an administrative process, which has to go through several offices, among others the FCI General Committee, and will therefore take whatever time that takes.

The breed clubs will of course inform when there is news in the matter.
